

Things to bring to make your life easier...

Please limit yourself to 1 suitcase and a carry on. Now, try to stuff enough clothes for the week in that 1 suitcase. Jeans are good for cool nights and shorts or swimsuits during the day. Bring plenty of t-shirts. You may want to bring a sweatshirt or sweater for evenings. It could be chilly!! Average lows during early June are in the 60's. Average highs are in the 80's. Don't forget socks and underwear. Bring some "closed-toed shoes" for activities and some flip flops for the pool. You'll want to bring some old, ratty clothes that you'd be ok throwing away, in case you get really muddy and bring one nicer set of clothes for a "banquet" night. You might also want to bring along something that looks a bit "country" for a dress-up night that we might have.

You might want to bring shampoo, soap, toothpaste, deodorant, etc. to make it easier to make and keep friends. If you wear contacts, don't forget to bring your contact stuff and some glasses, just in case. SharpTop provides your bed linens, pillows, and towels, but it's always good to bring an extra towel.

Don't bring any expensive jewelry. Having it lost or stolen will ruin your whole week.
